Last but not least, the fresh garbage plucked from the trash was useful and worthwhile:

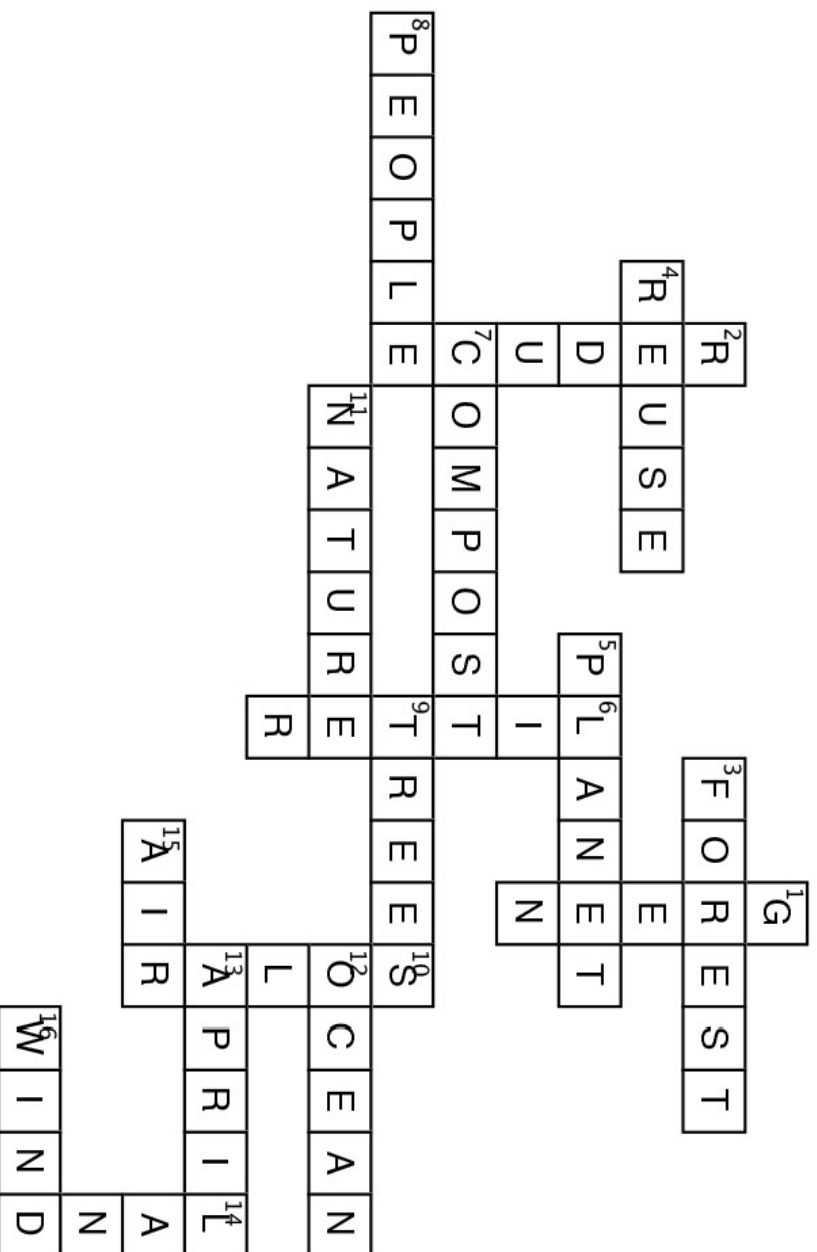
Sunday morning's **coffee grounds** and **2 eashells** were used to start a first-ever compost pile.
